

### Report on Engineers Day Celebrations Organized by NSS Cell - CREC 15-09-2022

Engineering is not merely knowing and being knowledgeable; engineering is not merely analysis; engineering is not merely the possession of the capacity to get elegant solutions to non-existent engineering problems; engineering is practicing the art of the organized forcing of technological change.

Engineers play a vital role in the development of a nation. Different parts of the country celebrate Engineer's Day to appreciate the contribution of engineers.

Every year September 15 is celebrated as Engineers' Day in India to commemorate one of India's finest engineers, Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya. M Visvesvaraya is considered one of the foremost nation-builders, creating marvels upon which modern India was built. He was referred as the 'precursor of economic planning in India', according to the Institution of Engineers India (IEI). M Visvesvaraya is also known as 'VM Sir' due to his various contributions to the field of engineering and being a pioneer of education.

Born on September 15, 1861, in a small village called Muddenahalli in Karnataka, Visvesvaraya received a degree in civil engineering from Pune College of Engineering. His expertise was in the fields of irrigation and flood disaster management. He rose to fame with his groundbreaking works in these fields with modern irrigation techniques as well as flood control and mitigation.

He later patented and installed an irrigation system with water floodgates at the Khadakvasla reservoir near Pune to raise the food supply level and storage to the highest levels. This was also installed at Gwalior's Tigra Dam and Mysuru's Krishnaraja Sagara (KRS) dam, the latter of which created one of the largest reservoirs in Asia at the time.

While serving as the Dison of Mysore, he was awarded 'Knight' in 1915 as a commander of the British Indian empire by King George Vands received the Bharat Ratna in 1955, became a member of



At last Prizes distributed for top three students and ten consolation prizes who performed well in short objective test on Constitution of India & Human Rights.





The principal and Director Dr. Bhaskar Patel and all the faculty members has attended the programme to make the event successful.



Cancer is one of the biggest health challenges we face today. Each year, millions of people are diagnosed with cancer around the world, and unfortunately more than half of the patients eventually will not survive. With nine million deaths, Cancer is the second-leading cause of death worldwide and to make it worse, The National Cancer Survivors Day Foundation predicts that that by 2026, more than 20 million people will be living with cancer or be survivors of cancer.





The most common types of cancer in males are lung cancer, prostate cancer, colorectal cancer, and stomach cancer. In females, the most common types are breast cancer, colorectal cancer, lung cancer, and cervical cancer.



National Pollution Control Day is a reminder of the tragedy that showed how pollution and the presence of toxic gases in the environment can be hazardous

The National Pollution Prevention Day also works towards spreading awareness regarding the pollution caused by industrial processes, industrial disasters and making people aware of the impact of pollution and significance to control the related acts.

The National Pollution Prevention Day remembers the night of 2-3 December when the leak and spread of Methyl Isocyanate gas (toxic) in the plant killed thousands of people. Bhopal Gas Tragedy is still known to be the world's worst industrial disaster to date. The after-effects of the accident were also severe as the increased cases of cancer and birth defects were reported.

The gas leak in the Bhopal disaster exposed over 5 lakh people to poisonous gas. As per the Official Records of the Madhya Pradesh Government, a total of 3,788 people were killed in the Bhopal gas leak and 5,74,366 people had sustained injuries.

National Pollution Prevention Day aims to aware of not only people but the authorities as well regarding the industrial pollutants and the impact they can have on future generations. The pollution control day is not only for the people who lost their lives but to also spread awareness on controlling and managing the industrial disasters which can happen due to human negligence.



Engineers play a vital role in the development of a nation. Different parts of the country celebrate Engineer's Day to appreciate the contribution of engineers.

Every year September 15 is celebrated as Engineers' Day in India to commemorate one of India's finest engineers, Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya. M Visvesvaraya is considered one of the foremost nation-builders, creating marvels upon which modern India was built. He was referred as the 'precursor of economic planning in India', according to the Institution of Engineers India (IEI). M Visvesvaraya is also known as 'VM Sir' due to his various contributions to the field of engineering and being a pioneer of education.

Born on September 15, 1861, in a small village called Muddenahalli in Karnataka, Visvesvaraya received a degree in civil engineering from Punc College of Engineering. His expertise was in the fields of irrigation and flood disaster management. He rose to fame with his groundbreaking works in these fields with modern irrigation techniques as well as flood control and mitigation.

He later patented and installed an irrigation system with water floodgates at the Khadakvasla reservoir near Pune to raise the food supply level and storage to the highest levels. This was also installed at Gwalior's Tigra Dam and Mysuru's Krishnaraja Sagara (KRS) dam, the latter of which created one of the largest reservoirs in Asia at the time.

While serving as the Doom of Mysore, he was awarded 'Knight' in 1915 as a commander of the British Indian empire by King George WHE received the Bharat Ratna in 1955, became a member of



This mobile application has a single carch SOS button that would help the women to alert the police control room and ensure a speedy response.

Android users can download this application from Google Play Store, whereas iOS users can download it from Apple App Store. The registration on the application can be done via mobile number.

#### Objective of the Session

- How it works? What could be possible alarming situations in routine life for women?
- What they are supposed to do in uncertain encounters?

He narrated various events caused to celebrate International Yoga day all over the world. Dr. Bhaskar DIRECTOR


Patel, Director said that Yoga was be best medicine to solve problems and to keep away from diseases.





Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar (14 April 1891 – 6 December 1956) popularly known as Baba Saheb was an Indian jurist, economist, politician and social reformer who inspired the Dalit Buddhist movement and campaigned against social discrimination against Untouchables (Dalits). He was a great man to organize the Dalit Movement. He also supported the rights of women and laborers. He was independent India's first law minister and the principal architect of the Constitution of India, the biggest and most complex constitution in the world. Due to which he is also known as the Father of the Indian Constitution. He established the Finance Commission of India. The Reserve Bank of India runs on guidelines and ideas formed by Ambedkar.

Beloved Principal Dr. P. Sanjeeva Rayadu in his speech highlighted Ambedkar as a brilliant student earning doctorates in economics from both Columbia University and the London School of Economics.
